What a wonderful Groundbreaking event we had on Pentecost, June 5th. The Holy Spirit was present in this place!

As we look to the start of seeing our new multi-purpose worship space go up, our Session will be meeting in August to discuss ways to fund-raise to supplement our insurance settlement. We have a lofty goal of ~ 1 million dollars to raise and are exploring different revenue streams including applying for a \$200,000 Presbytery Grant and a \$98,000 Synod Grant. Please keep these two grants in prayer as well as our upcoming Capital Campaign. We move forward knowing that "God has the power to provide more than enough...that we will have everything we need always and in everything to provide more than enough for every kind of good work." 2 Cor. 9:8.

MagPres Welcomes Family Promise Executive Director



Who's Who on CE? Chaired by Elder Zach Gipson, with Elder Kayla Crossen, Carla Carrasco, Danielle Good, Lisa MacDougall, and Adam Martinez.



Roles and Responsibilities (as stated in the Standing Rules of Session):

- 1. Assist Session in interpreting, establishing, and meeting the Church's Christian Education needs
- Oversee the Church's education programs, including but not limited to: Sunday School, Middle School and Senior High youth programming, adult programs, Vacation Bible School, Life Groups, and the Church Library
- 3. Review and monitor curriculum on an ongoing basis to ensure appropriate implementation within specific programs
- 4. Adopt new curriculum, subject to Session approval
- 5. Recruit, train, and schedule teachers/leaders/volunteers (including working with the Personnel Committee to ensure background checks and Child Safety Trainings are completed and recommending to Session for approval new teachers/leaders/volunteers)
- 6. Oversee, with the Personnel Committee, the Youth Leader and Nursery Attendant
- 7. Oversee child-care for all Church functions
- 8. Develop an annual committee budget, in coordination with the Stewardship and Finance Committee, and manage committee budget on a monthly basis
- 9. Oversee other funds related to its work, in conjunction with the Stewardship and Finance committee


