sabbatical [səˈbadək(ə)l]

NOUN a period of paid leave granted to a university teacher or other worker for study or travel, traditionally one year for every seven years worked.

The History of Sabbatical and Sabbath: Take a Break

We tend to think of *sabbatical* in academic terms, as a school year free from teaching duties that can be devoted to research, travel, and writing. Traditionally, this occurs every seventh year. Because of this scholarly context, we may easily miss what is hiding in plain sight: that *sabbatical* is related to *Sabbath*, which refers to the Biblical day of rest, or the seventh day. We trace the origins of both *sabbatical* and *Sabbath* to the Greek word *sabbaton*. *Sabbaton* itself traces to the Hebrew word *shabbāth*, meaning "rest."

The Old Testament refers to God's "day of rest" most famously in Genesis, but *Sabbath* referring to an entire year of rest is mentioned in Leviticus (25:3-5):

³ You will plant your fields for six years, and prune your vineyards and gather their crops for six years. ⁴ But in the seventh year the land will have a special sabbath rest, a Sabbath to the LORD: You must not plant your fields or prune your vineyards. ⁵ You must not harvest the secondary growth of your produce or gather the grapes of your freely growing vines. It will be a year of special rest for the land.

All this is to say I will be taking my Sabbatical, no not for a year, but for the month of August. It's hard to believe it has been almost 8 years since my Ordination and Installation. What a jam-packed time it has been! One of the things I will be doing during my time away is participating in a week long Spiritual Journey Retreat offered through an organization called Stillpoint. As a part of this week I will be meeting with a cohort group online to practice, discuss, study, and discern the discipline of Spiritual Direction. I will also be spending some time at the beach and possibly playing my guitar, creating mosaics or exploring other art mediums.

While I will miss everyone, I am also looking forward to this time of study and renewal. In order for me to decompress and completely disengage from my job duties I am going to set some boundaries for myself such as staying off email, Facebook, and anything else relating to MagPres. I imagine this will be very difficult for me and because of that I am asking for your support. It would be helpful to me for you all to not only hold me accountable, but to refrain from contacting me for any reason. Pastor Paul has been very supportive about me taking this time especially considering the time we're in. Please check-in on him from time to time-
